Completed Application, transcript and letters of recommendation must be submitted via email no later than 5:00 PM, Monday, March 8, 2021
Registration is now open.

Complete this two-part application by assembling the following:

Part 1

2. You will receive an electronic confirmation message by email

Part 2

1. **Contact two references** and ask for letters of recommendation from:
 - a. An Academic Advisor/ Community Engagement Coordinator/Representative who knows your work with the college social justice, advocacy, or community outreach programs as your supervisor during your service or project.
 - b. Your Coach , who has been working with you in the High Potential program.
